The total number of hours may be applied collectively across all units of competency that include the requirement for workplace hours.

Entry Requirements and Selection Process:



LLN: Skilled Up will assess participant's language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) level, prior to course enrolment, to ascertain their readiness and determine any support requirements, to complete the qualification. The ACSF level 3 require for entry in Certificate IV Education Support.
